What Is Kinnections?

The Kinnections Program connects First Nations youth, aged 16-19 years old, with volunteer mentors. Youth must commit to meeting with their mentor once per week, for a minimum of one year. Youth remain active in the program until they turn 20 years old.

Our goal is to provide youth with life skills training in hopes that these skills will assist youth with their transition into adulthood.

Youth set their own goals and volunteer mentors assist youth to achieve those goals.
